



### **COVID-19 Limited Re-Opening Policy and Procedures**

- Upon arrival at the rink, skaters and coaches are to use the front entrance of the building, entering using the right-hand doors and following the arrows to the right-hand staircase leading down to dressing room area.
- The purchaser of the ice/main contact will make sure all participants are screened for COVID-19 based on the information and they have collected contact information to support contact tracing. (See form and the end of this document).
- Masks must be worn at all times, inside the facility, with the exception of the on-ice portion of the visit
- No spectators
- ONE parent/guardian of children is permitted to enter the skate tying area of the facility to tie their children's skates if they are incapable of doing so. (No sibling, friends, girlfriends, etc.. will be permitted in the facility).

- ONE parent/guardian per player will be permitted to supervise in the designated viewing areas per hourly session (must be the same individual as above) – **SOCIAL DISTANCING MUST BE PRACTICED WHILE OBSERVING THE SKATE** failure to do so will be grounds for removal from the facility. (No sibling, friends, girlfriends etc.. will be permitted in the facility).
- Rooms will be assigned to groups and teams. Overflow chairs can be found in the hallways outside of each room
- **Personal belongings may now be left in assigned dressing rooms. Skaters dressing in hall areas may store their bags in their teams' room during the skate.**
- **DO NOT EXCEED THE POSTED CAPACITY FOR EACH ROOM**
- **Although scrimmaging and gameplay are now permitted on the ice surface, Body checking will not be permitted.**
- **No showering is permitted at the Minto Skating Centre**
- All participants must exit the facility within 15 minutes of the completion of their ice time so the Dressing Rooms can be disinfected after each use
- Use the main staircase in the middle of the dressing room hallway and follow the arrow to exit the facility
